EDWARD ALWIN HARTLEY

Edward Alwin Hartley was the second-born son of William (Lawrence) and Mina (Bindseil) Hartley. (Note: "Alwin" is a German name that is pronounced "Alvin." Ed was born on his brother Michael's first birthday April 28, 1946 in San Pedro, CA. Because they shared a birthday and were only one year apart in age, they always had a special bond.



ily home, and he graduated with his brother, Matthew, from Clearwater High School in 1993.


