My Grandma Hartley lived in Ava, MO, and I remember going to her house and push mowing her yard. My siblings and I grew up in the country outside Wichita, and Grandma Hartley lived in Ava, MO. So when we were visiting her, we would go walk the streets and see the town. That was a neat experience for us.

In November 2007, Sandy accepted a job working for Wal-Mart pharmacy as a pharmacy technician.

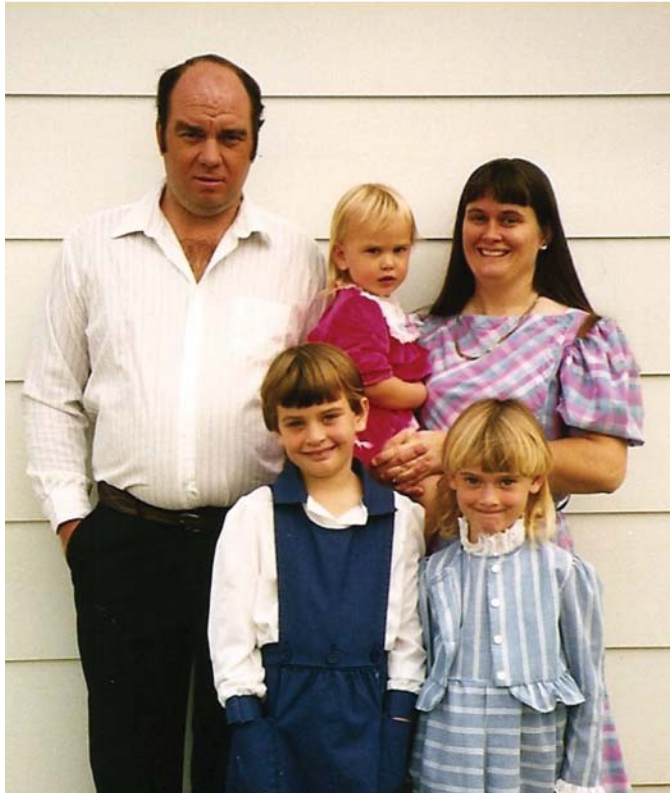
Sandy and I had three daughters: Cindy born on August 19, 1982; Cheryl born on October 28, 1984; and Christy born April 14, 1988.
